That day our traveling companions shared an eclectic cluster of songs. There was a beautiful chant by a Native American children's choir and some fast paced something that I had a difficult time discerning.

One of their selections was Tim McGraw singing Lori McKenna's song "Humble and Kind." The lilt of lyrics led our grandchildren to join in, "Hold the door, say 'Please', say 'Thank you'. I found these to be the Christian values I worked to instill in my children. Today, via Lori's venues and Tim McGraw's country music ties, this timeless message about staying grounded in kindness, humility and compassion reaches people of all ages.

That day in the car, on the highway and biways of life, as Charles, our driver, took us safely to our destination, I paused to ponder the past, the present and the future. I said a quiet prayer of gratitude for our dynamic duo in the backseat. And they, holding imaginary microphones, swaying back and forth as far as their seatbelts would allow, continued to sing.
